Storage Tips

Unit Size

Amount It Stores

5' x 10'

Residential: Furnishings for a one bedroom apartment, chairs, mattress set, and several boxes

Business: About 90 filing boxes and small filing cabinets

10' x 10'

Residential: Furnishings for a one or two bedroom apartment, a couch, boxes, and a desk

Business: About 180 filing boxes and office furniture

10' x 15'

Residential: Furnishings for a three bedroom apartment, tools, boxes, and a washer/dryer or refrigerator

Business: About 300 filing boxes, office furniture, and filing cabinets

10' x 20'

Residential: Small home furnishings, tools / equipment, a small boat, washer / dryer, refrigerator, and a small vehicle

Business: About 390 filing boxes and small office furniture

10' x 30'

Residential: Large home furnishings,
machine tools, pool tables, dining room sets, etc ...

Business: About 600 filing boxes, office furniture,
additional equipment and inventory

Storage / Packing Tips

Always remember to lock your unit, locks
are available from Swanzey Self Storage.

Make use of empty space such as drawers and cabinets for fragile
items.

Label boxes so they can be stored properly and found easily.

Always fill boxes completely to prevent boxes from caving in.

Stuffing boxes with towels, blankets, packing paper, or bubble wrap

can prevent damage to fragile items.

Store items such as clothes, dishes, tools, etc...

- Do not store paint, bleach, or other combustible items

- Do not store perishable items such as food

If you are storing a bedroom set, make sure the mattress is covered and lying on a level surface.

Do not store wet items, dry them before storing them to prevent mold and mildew.

Use protective covers for wooden and cloth items so they are less likely to be damaged by mold, mildew, or dust.
